When selecting a presidential candidate to lead their party of choice, will be on Tuesday, March 24, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. That day, voters should report to one of the 11 pre-assigned Union County precincts.

Registered voters who will be at least 18 years of age by Election Day will be eligible to vote during early voting, though Monday, Feb. 24, was the registration deadline for voters looking to participate in the Presidential Preference Primary.

For information on

applying for an absentee ballot, visit the Georgia Secretary of State’s Office website at sos.ga.gov; swing by the Union County Registrar’s Office at 65 Courthouse Street in Blairsville; or call 706-439-6016.

Voters can access mvp.sos.ga.gov ahead of the election for information on voter registration status, mail-in application and ballot status, poll location, registration information on file with the county office, sample ballots and more.

The next election to

be held after the Presidential Preference Primary Election is the General Primary Election on May 19, during which voters will be selecting candidates for various local, state and federal offices to lead their party of choice in the Nov. 3 General Election.

A Nonpartisan General Election will run concurrently with the General Primary on May 19, and winners there will be sworn into office in 2020.

The voter registration deadline for the May 19 elections will be April 20.
